Seeing Kaaba

Read this dua and then make your own dua

Step 1: Going to state of Ihram

(a) Dhul Hulaifah

Pray 2 Rakat Salah (Surah Kafiroon + Ikhlas)

(b) Niyyah

لَبَّيْكَ اللَّهُمَّ عُمْرَةً

Labbayka llāhumma ‘umratan.

○ Allah, here I am to perform Umrah.

Step 1: Going to state of Ihram

(c) Saying Talbiyah

لَبَّيْكَ اللَّهُمَّ لَبَّيْكَ – لَبَّيْكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ لَبَّيْكَ – إِنَّ الْحَمْدَ وَالنَّعْمَةَ
لَكَ وَالْمُلْكَ – لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ –

Labbayka llāhumma labbayk(a), labbayka lā sharīka laka labbayk(a), inna l-ḥamda wa n-ni‘mata, laka wa l-mulk(a), lā sharīka lak.

At Your service, Allah, at Your service. At Your service, You have no partner, at Your service. Truly all praise, favour and sovereignty are Yours. You have no partner.

Step 2: Tawaf al-Umrah (7 circuit)

○ Allah, I intend to perform Tawaf of your Sacred House, so make it easy for me and accept it from me.

1. Make Wudu. Make Niyyah for Tawaf al Umrah (above)
2. Line yourself with Hajre Aswad. Turn towards Kaabah. Men keep your right shoulder exposed throughout the Tawaf only for the **first** Tawaf (‘Tawaf of Arrival,’ Tawaf al-Qudum)
3. Raise your right hand (palm facing al-Hajar al-Aswad). Say **Bismillah Allahu Akbar**, put your hands down
4. Start walking anti-clockwise. After every circuit at Hajre Aswad raise your hand and say **Allahu Akbar**.
5. Read any dua
6. Between Rukn Yemeni and Hajre Aswad read:
Rabbānā ātinā fi d-dunyā ḥasanatan wafī l-ākhirati ḥasanatan wa qinā ‘adhāba n-nār.



Step 3: Makam Ibrahim

Pray 2 Rakah Salah behind Makam Ibrahim

وَاتَّخِذُوا مِنْ مَّقَامِ إِبْرَاهِيمَ مُصَلًّى

Wattakhidhu min maqāmi Ibrāhīma muṣalla.

And take the Maqam Ibrahim as a place of Salah.

1. Find a place to pray behind Makah Ibrahim
2. Read above while walking to your prayer place
3. Pray 2 Rakah (Better Surah Kafiroom and Ikhlās)



Step 4: Drink Zamzam

Before Drinking Zamzam

make an intention that its consumption will be a means of fulfilling your wishes, whether that is good health, success in this world, or protection from the tribulations of the grave. Say **Bismillah**

While Drinking Zamzam Face Kaabah

After Drinking Zamzam Say Alhamdulillah and read the following dua

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ عِلْمًا نَافِعًا وَرِزْقًا وَاسِعًا وَعَمَلًا مُتَقَبَّلًا وَشِفَاءً مِنْ

كُلِّ دَاءٍ

Allahumma innī as'aluka 'ilman nāfi'an, wa rizqan wāsi'an, wa 'amalan mutaqaabbalan, wa shifā'an min kullī dā'.



Step 5: Sai Start

Go towards Mount Safa and while going recite

إِنَّ الصَّفَا وَالْمَرْوَةَ مِنْ شَعَائِرِ اللَّهِ

Inna ṣ-ṣafā wa l-marwata min sha'a'iri llāh(i).

Indeed, Safa and Marwa are from the Signs of Allah.

Then say and start walking towards Marwa

أَبْدَأُ بِمَا بَدَأَ اللَّهُ بِهِ

Abda'u bimā bad'allahu bihi.

I begin with that which Allah has begun with.



Step 5: Sai Recurring

Every time you reach Safa or Marwa face Kaabah and recite

"Alhamdulillah, walaa ilaha illallahu, wallahu Abkar."

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ لَا شَرِيكَ لَهُ، لَهُ الْمُلْكُ وَلَهُ الْحَمْدُ يُحْيِي وَيُمِيتُ،

وَهُوَ عَلَى كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Lā ilāha illallāh waḥdahū lā sharīka lah(u), lahu l-mulku wa lahu l-ḥamdu yuḥyī
wa yumīt(u), wa huwa ‘alā kulli shay’in qadīr.

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَحْدَهُ، أَنْجَزَ وَعْدَهُ وَنَصَرَ عَبْدَهُ وَهَزَمَ الْأَحْزَابَ وَحْدَهُ

Lā ilāha illallāhu waḥdah(u), anjaza wa’dahu wa naṣara ‘abdahu wa ḥazama l-
aḥzāba waḥdah.

Then make your dua



Step 6: Leave Haram and Shave your head

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَالصَّلَاةِ وَالسَّلَامِ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ، اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ
فَضْلِكَ

Bismi llāhi, wa ṣ-ṣalātu wa s-salāmu ‘ala rasūli llāh. Allāhumma innī as’aluka
min faḍlik.
